



Coaches Code of Conduct

1. Follow and be knowledgeable on all MCU Club, CWSL, and WYSA, US Youth Assoc., & FIFA rules.
2. Respect - You are to show respect at all times for coaches, officials, players, spectators, and opponents. Do not argue with referees, linesman, spectators, or coaches. Disrespect will not be tolerated and could result in immediate club termination.
3. Never verbally or physically abuse a player, official, parent, spectator or other coach.
4. Profanity - **ZERO TOLERANCE.** Use of profanity is strictly prohibited on the field, hotels, restaurants, or any other location that team members are present.
5. Care more about the child than winning the game—winning is a consideration, but not the only one, nor the most important.
6. Be concerned with the overall development of your players. Stress good health habits and clean living.
7. Give all players the opportunity to improve their skills, gain confidence, and develop self-esteem.
8. Adjust to each player's personal needs and challenges. Be a good listener.
9. Encourage all of your players to be team players.
10. Be generous with your praise when deserved; be consistent, honest, fair and just.
11. Never criticize players publically.
12. Maintain an open line of communication with your players and their parents.
13. Teach the basics, continue to study and learn the game to become a better coach and communicator.
14. Organize practices that are challenging and fun for **ALL** of your players.
15. Intentionally damaging MC United Soccer equipment and or facilities.
