Visitors' Guide

We are proud to be hosting your team on some of the best soccer fields in the Midwest. Competitive play and a welcoming soccer experience is what we strive to achieve at our tournaments. We encourage all players, coaches, and spectators at every level to keep this attitude in mind throughout the tournament.

COACH / PLAYER / SPECTATOR CONDUCT (Important)

Harassment of officials will not be tolerated. Referees may temporarily stop games or suspend play in the presence of persistent sideline harassment or intimidation. In the case of a game suspension, the Tournament director will decide the outcome of the game.

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of players, parents and spectators at the fields, hotels and other locations for the duration of the tournament. If the tournament receives complaints regarding conduct of any player or person associated with your team, the Tournament Director may ask any/all people to stay away from the tournament, and/or ask the team to leave the tournament, and/or ban the team from future tournaments. Any ejections will require the offender to be "out of sight and out of sound" from the field area before the match is restarted.

TOURNAMENT APP - COMMUNICATIONS, SCHEDULES & SCORING

The primary platform for tournament communications will be the TeamSnap Tournaments mobile app. All coaches, managers, and parents are strongly encouraged to download the app and enable notifications so we can best communicate to all during the weekend.

To download the TeamSnap Tournaments app, go to the Google Play Store or Apple App Store to find the "TeamSnap Tournaments" mobile app. Once downloaded search for the "MC United Fall Cup 10th Annual" and select as a favorite. Then "STAR" your teams for a customized schedule on the homepage.

A link to scores and schedules may also be posted on the tournament's webpage. QR codes will be available around the complex for quick access to the schedules and scores as well.

Other forms of communication that will be updated as time allows are Facebook and the tournament website.

PARKING

There is NO parking fee for this event. Due to the large number of visitors the parking lots can become very congested at times.
