We encourage all players, coaches, and spectators at every level to keep this attitude in mind throughout the tournament

COACH / PLAYER / SPECTATOR CONDUCT (Important)

Harassment of officials will not be tolerated. Referees may temporarily stop games or suspend play in the presence of persistent sideline harassment or intimidation. In case of a game suspension, the Tournament director will decide the game's outcome.

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of players, parents and spectators at the facility for the duration of the tournament. If the tournament receives complaints regarding the conduct of any player or person associated with your team, the Tournament Director may ask any/all people to stay away from the tournament, and/or ask the team to leave the tournament. Any ejections will require the offender to be "out of sight and out of sound" from the field area before the match is restarted.

TEAMSNAPE ROSTERS AND WAIVERS (Important)

Only players that have accepted the digital invitation and completed the online waiver will be allowed to play on the day of the tournament.

TOURNAMENT APP - COMMUNICATIONS, SCHEDULES & SCORING

The primary platform for tournament communications will be the TeamSnap Tournaments mobile app. All coaches, managers, and parents are strongly encouraged to download the app and enable notifications so we can communicate best to all during the weekend.

To download the TeamSnap Tournaments app, go to the Google Play Store or Apple App Store to find the "TeamSnap Tournaments" mobile app. Once downloaded search for the "Winter Classic" and select as a favorite. Then "STAR" your teams for a customized schedule on the homepage.

A link to scores and schedules may also be posted on the tournament's webpage. QR codes will be available around the facility for quick access to the schedules and scores.

Facebook and the tournament website will also be used for any broad communication.

ADMISSION FEE

There is a required admission fee for spectators at this event to help cover operating costs. Admission fees will be collected at the main entrance and wristbands will be provided to help identify tournament visitors from other facility users. Cash and credit card payments will be accepted. Coaches and players have no admission fee.

Adult - \$5 Children – 10 & under (Free)

SEATING

Spectators can watch from elevated balconies or on the bleachers on the field level. **No spectators are allowed on turf field or in restricted warm-up / team spaces.** No folding chairs are allowed within the facility. Please follow the posted signage for approved seating areas.

EQUIPMENT

Standard soccer cleats or turf-type shoes are recommended for playing on the artificial turf surface. Metal cleats are not permitted. Shin guards are required to be worn by all players. GKs may want to wear appropriate attire to protect their arms and legs from turf burn. See the tournament rules for details.

NO FOOD OR GUM

No food or gum is permitted on or near the field surface. This is to help keep the surface clean and in good condition.

PLAYER HYDRATION

The facility has multiple water bottle refilling stations and athletic drinks will be for sale at the concession stand.

FACILITY RULES

This facility is owned and maintained by the Greenheck Turner Community Center / DC Everest School District. Fans and teams are expected to follow facility rules and help be respectful users of this amazing venue.

TOURNAMENT APPAREL
