MC United Girls Program Spring Season League Update



Dear MC United Families,

We would like to share an important update regarding our Girls Soccer Teams for the upcoming spring season.

At the December Board of Directors meeting, the MC United board voted in favor of moving our girls teams from the Central Wisconsin Soccer League (CWSL) to the East Central Soccer League (ECSL) beginning this spring. This league is based in the greater Fox Valley Area (Green Bay/Appleton/Oshkosh). The website for this league and additional information can be found at https://eastcentralsoccer.com/ This decision was made after thoughtful discussion and careful consideration, and it was not taken lightly.

The primary reason for this change is the lack of appropriate competition for our girls teams within CWSL. ECSL offers stronger overall competition, including tiered divisions that are age appropriate, which we believe will better support player development, challenge our athletes, and enhance their overall soccer experience. The girls program will pilot this move during the spring season to evaluate its long-term fit for the club.

What this means for girls soccer families this spring:

One league game per week from late April through the end of June - 8 in total

- Up to five away games in the Fox Valley area (Oshkosh, Neenah, and the Green Bay area) but likely four.
- Up to four home games
- Spring league games are played on weeknights for U11 and Above
- U9-10 league games are played on Saturdays. They won't have to play all 8 weeks (choose which dates to play)

We recognize that this represents a change from previous seasons and may require a longer commute one evening per week. The board acknowledges that this can add stress for families; however, we strongly believe that the benefits of consistent scheduling (one game per week) and higher-quality competition outweigh the additional travel.

We understand that this change may not be feasible for every family. To support our players and families, MC United is offering the option for girls players to decommit from the spring season and receive a full registration refund if you have already registered.
