JERSEY UPDATE

This spring is the LAST season of our current jersey. Jerseys are ONLY NEEDED if you are brand new to MC United OR you need a new size. You will be receiving an email with a link to order uniforms by mid-March. We will communicate with you further on this when the ordering process starts.

FYI: FALL SEASON BRINGS AGE GROUP CHANGES

The Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association (WYSA), following the lead of its governing body US Youth Soccer, will switch from the current calendar year age groups to seasonal-year age groups (August 1 to July 31) beginning with the FALL 2026 season.

This change aims to align soccer teams with school grade levels, allowing more players to compete alongside their classmates.

Effective Date: The new age group cut-offs will take effect starting with the Fall 2026 season. The 2026 spring season will continue using the current birth year rules (January 1 to December 31).
