What we expect from Parents:

- Encourage – don’t coach from the sideline
- Respect referee decisions
- No confrontations with game officials
- 24-hour rule before discussing concerns
- Support all players

POLICIES & EXPECTATIONS: PLAYING TIME

Below are the standards used by coaches for general management of playing time over the course of the season:

- U9 and U10: Nearly Equal Playing time
- U11 and U12: Approximately equal (e.g. 40% – 60%)
- U13 and Up: Minimum 30% target, but subject to the coach's discretion based on technical and tactical abilities of the players.
- State teams (all ages): There are no minimum playing time targets for individual games; playing time is subject to the coach's discretion based on technical and tactical abilities of the players.

Coaches may reduce playing time at their discretion for individual players due to any of the following:

- Poor attendance and/or punctuality at practices and/or games
- Poor effort, attitude, and/or behavior during practices and/or games
- Poor fitness level, including injuries
- Inability to work/play well with teammates

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT PATHWAY

- **U8–U10: Foundation Phase**

- Ball mastery
- Confidence & creativity
- Introduction to tactical concepts
- Development focus

- **U11–U14: Development Phase**

- Tactical awareness
- Position understanding/mastery
- Physical development
- Introduction to performance accountability

- **U15–U19: Performance Phase**

- Competitive awareness
- Analysis, performance standards
- Leadership & responsibility
- College exposure (where applicable)


COACHING STRUCTURE

- Tournaments guarantee 3 games for all teams. U10 & Under: 3 games – no tournament winner. U11+: Tournament Winners Decided
- Schedules released about 2 weeks before each tournament. Tournaments use different apps! Coaches/Managers will communicate with the team your schedule and where to find information for each tournament once they become available.



HOME TOURNAMENT: MOUNTAIN BAY CUP

May 1-3 is our Home Tournament at Peoples Sports Complex with overflow games at Airport Park

- VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENT: All families are required to volunteer a shift at the home tournament. Shifts vary from field marshals to concessions to tournament logistics. This allows us to organize and run the tournament. All proceeds from the tournament go directly to the club.
 - Sign up will be out in APRIL.
 - Volunteers will be tracked and those who do not volunteer will be assessed the \$50 penalty.

Boys Classic: Central Wisconsin Soccer League


- 10 Games from mid/late May to end of June/early July (2 per week)
